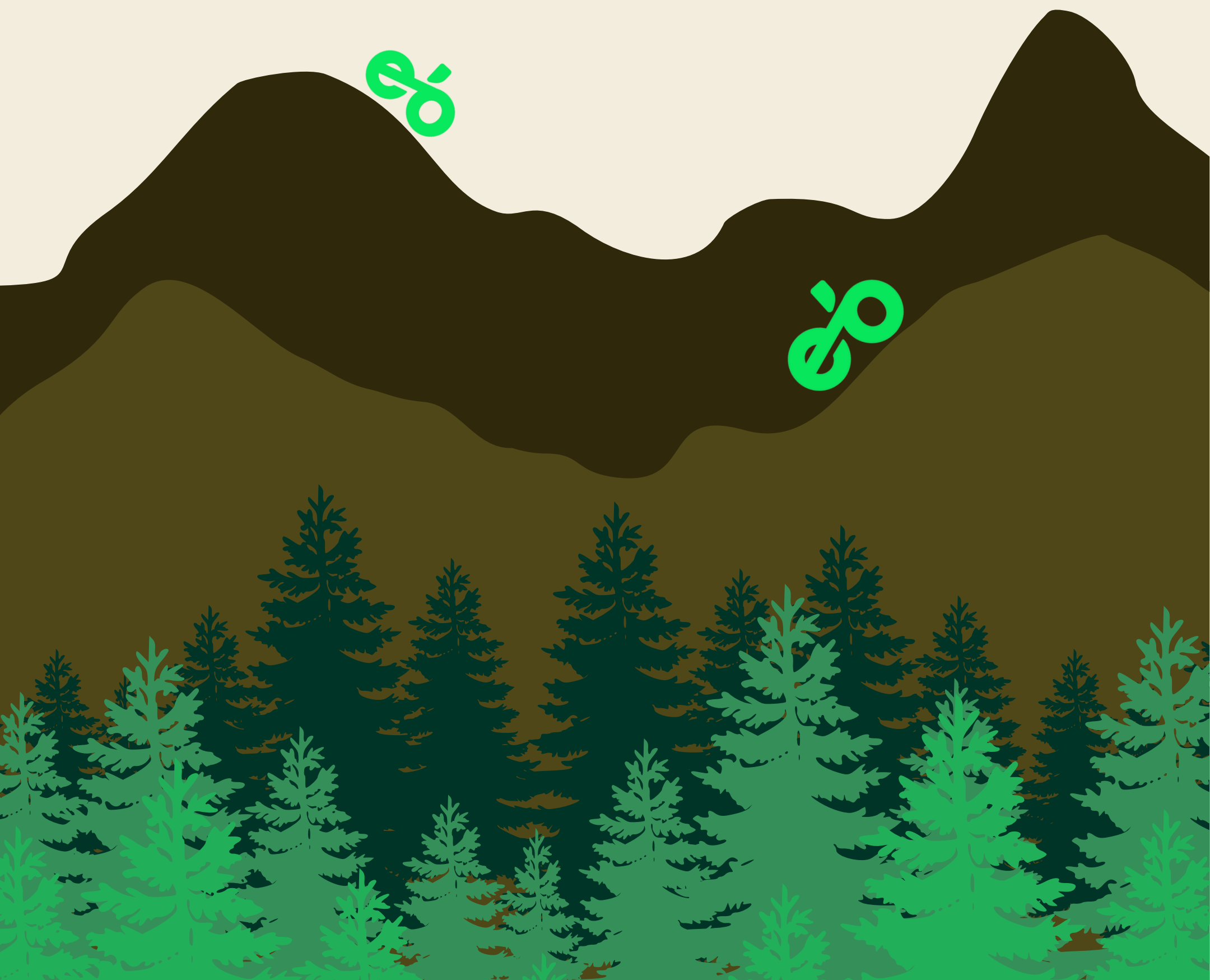

Our guides will take you to the most emblematic places, such as the lookout point, the flower garden, the library park and the handicrafts market.





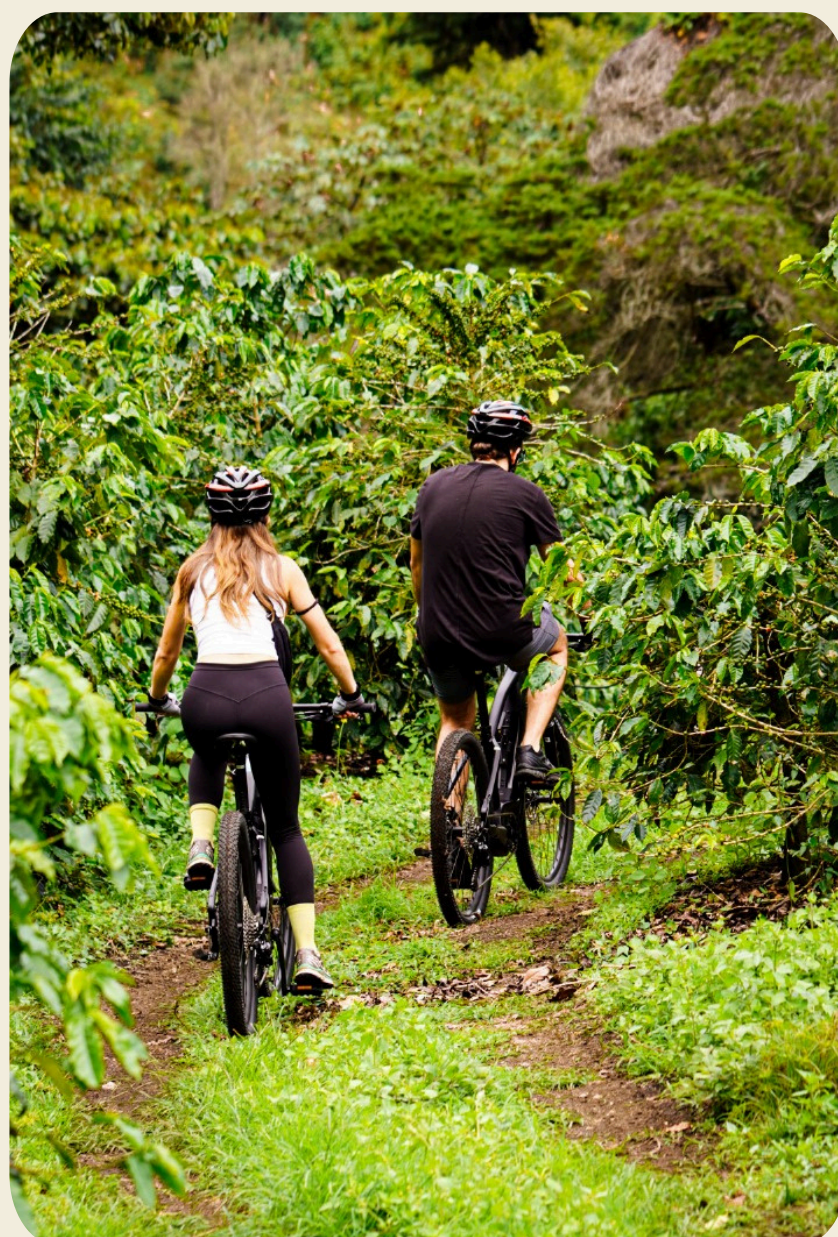

Lost Waterfalls

Three stunning waterfalls in the lush rainforest.

Suitable for almost everyone with medium difficulty. Recommended to get into the second waterfall.

\$10 entrance fee.

El Pianista Trail

Hike through cloud forests and panoramic views.

No cost and high difficulty. Accompanied by a guide if possible.



Hikes and Outdoor Adventures

Volcán Barú

Iconic hike to the highest peak in Panama.

1. You can hike up via Boquete (total 26km round trip) without a guide.

Recommended to see the sunrise, start the hike around midnight.

2. Or you can hike up Volcán (7.5km climb with quite a bit of elevation) which is 100% trail. You must go with a guide to be allowed past the sentry box.

El Tatica

Easy hike takes only 10 to 15 minutes and leads you through beautiful cloud forests.

\$5 entrance fee.

La Artillería Hike

Rugged trail offers an adventure for those looking to experience Boquete's more remote landscapes.

La Piedra de la India Vieja

Adventurous and rugged trail rewarded with stunning views. Moderate difficulty.

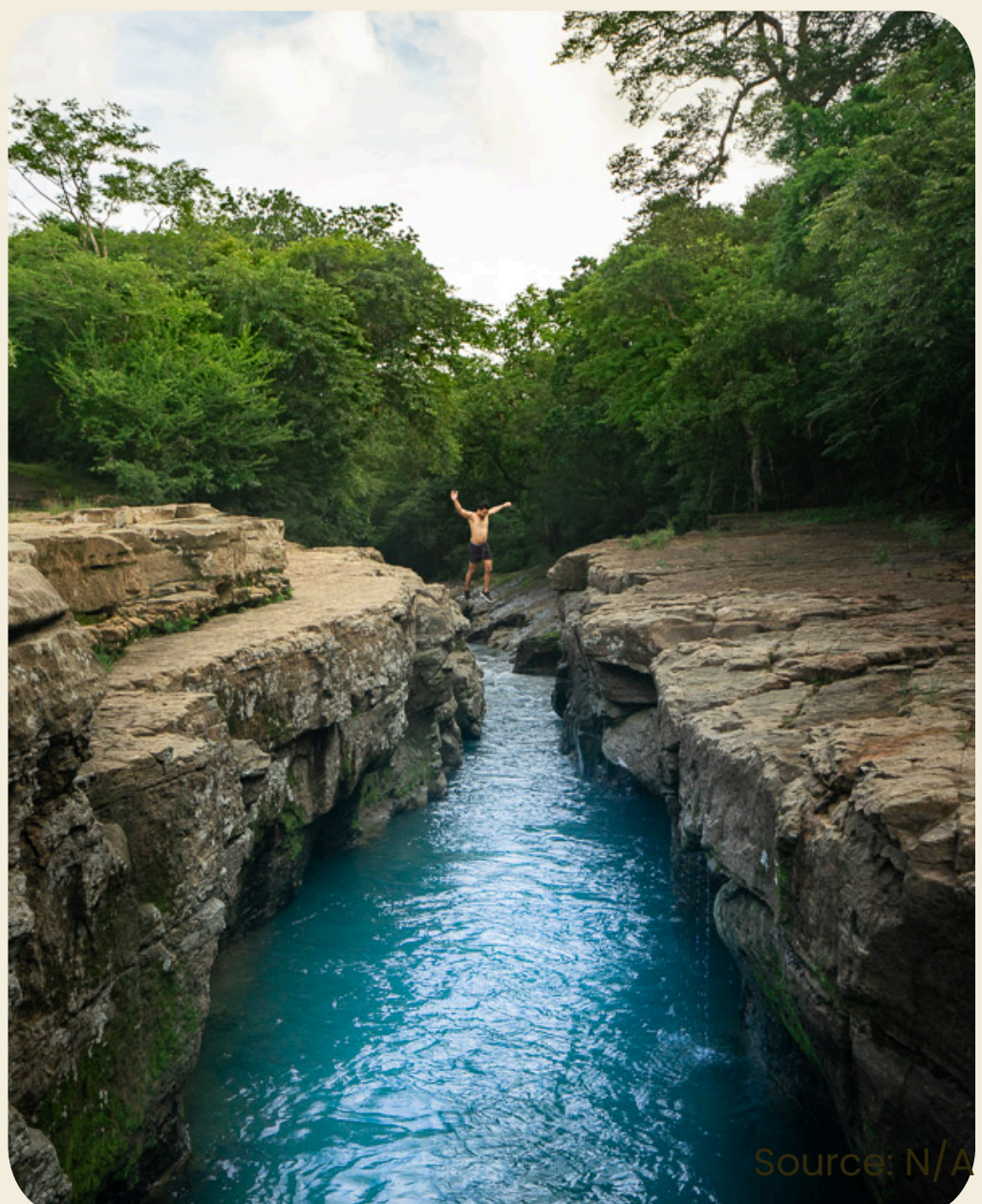
Sendero Piedra de Lino

Cangilones de Gualaca

This natural rock formation creates perfect swimming pools along a river.

Easy trail of 1.5 hours. It is known for its lush rainforest, small waterfalls, and wildlife sightings. \$5 entrance fee.

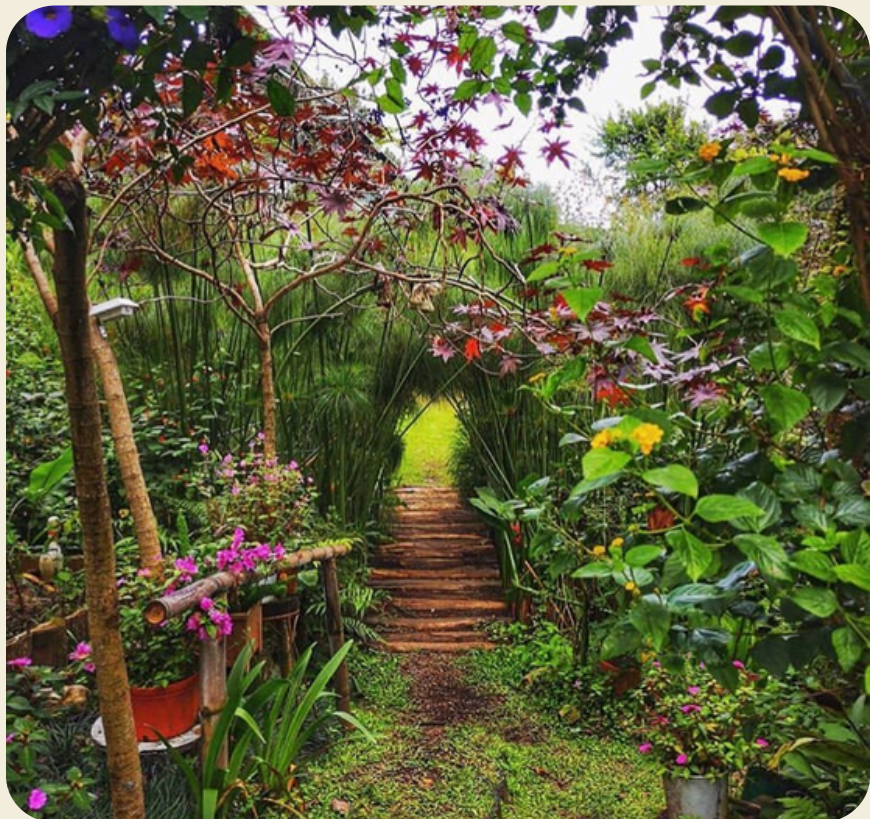
Boquete Bees and Butterflies

This honey farm specializes in high-quality honey varieties. The tour offers exploring the farm, visiting coffee plantations, a butterfly lab, and learning about stingless bees. \$6 to \$45 entrance fee.

Features a peaceful walkway along the river. It's one of our favorite spots in Boquete, perfect for a relaxing stroll.



Panamonte Bridge

Located near Hotel Ladera, next to the bridge is a hidden stone path along the river, ideal for a quiet walk amidst nature.
